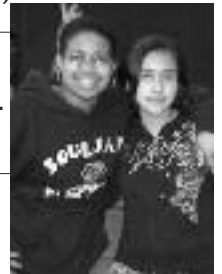

Aquatic Policy

Please do not ask the Front Desk or Registrar which class to enroll your child in; please see/call an Aquatics person.

Please do not leave the building while your child is swimming due to unexpected needs your child may have. Please do not change children on pool deck.

SWIM ABILITY TESTING:

Evaluations, available by appointment, are scheduled during youth swim times. Please call the Aquatic Department at 914-666-8069 ext. 117.

LESSONS: Sept. 13 - Nov 17, 2010

Please check in at Front Desk prior to each class. During the first week of class if Aquatic staff determines that your child is not ready (or too advanced) for the class he/she is registered in, you will be given a request to change card by staff. Go to Front Desk with change card to make changes.

SPECTATOR DAYS:

September 13-18, Nov 11-24
(This is the only time available to observe on the deck.)

EVALUATION WEEK: Nov 11-17. Swimmers will be evaluated to determine degree of achievement. No child fails; they are merely delayed until able to master all required skills.

MAKE-UP WEEK: Nov 18-24. First make-up is to be scheduled on your day and time. Second make-up is based on availability (If you miss your make-up, there is no make-up for it.) Schedule second makeups at Front Desk before Nov 18.

ELECTRICAL STORMS: In accordance with Public Health & Safety Laws, Aquatic classes will be halted in severe electrical storms. If the class has been in session for at least 15 minutes, there will be no make-up.

LOCKERS are for use only during the time you are in the building. If locks are left on, they are subject to removal without prior notice. We are not responsible for locks or personal items.

SWIM CAPS must be worn by all swimmers whose hair is below their ears, except Water Explorers. Caps may be purchased at the Front Desk.

ILLNESS: Please do not send children to lessons if they are ill, have a cold, cough or fever. Skin and eye infections will exempt class participation.

FAMILY SWIM: Sat 2:00-3:00. Free for Members and Parent/Guardian. Parent/Guardian must accompany Club member, wear bathing suit and be in the water. Swim cap rule is in effect. **No spectators allowed at this time.**

YOUTH SWIM: Mon-Th 3:00-4:00pm and Sat 12:00-1:00. Free to all members age 8 and up. Must be in Level 3 or higher or stand 50 inches at chin. Swim cap rule is in effect.

Pre-School Safety & Swim Programs

1/2 Hour Classes Fees - Mon, Th, Sat: \$150; Tues, Wed: \$165

Multiple Child Discount applies.

Using American Red Cross standards, these programs build swimming readiness through guided practice within a safe and fun atmosphere. Elementary skills taught include: kicking on front/back, blowing bubbles, arm/stroke execution, and body coordination. Safety skills are also taught. Swim caps are required for children in 3 year class and up if hair is below the ears.
